**RE: Construction update for Fraser Grain Terminal Export Facility – Rammed Aggregate Piers (RAP)**

We are writing to provide information on upcoming construction activities for the Fraser Grain Terminal Export facility at 11041 Elevator Road, adjacent to Fraser Surrey Docks.

We would like to notify you of upcoming noisy work associated with RAP installation (stone columns). Stone column work is a method of ground densification that uses vibration to compact aggregate materials within the ground. This work is scheduled to commence on 5 September and will take approximately two weeks to complete.

**What to expect**

Construction activities will include the following:

- Hours of work for construction activities will be consistent with the port authority's approved hours of construction: 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday (excluding statutory holidays).
- A temporary increase in noise and dust levels around the Project site is anticipated during construction. Dust-generating activities will be limited during dry conditions and periods of high wind.
- Neighbours may hear construction noise typically associated with this type of work including pile driving for ground improvement activities. RAPs will be installed using vibratory rather than hammer methods to minimize noise levels as much as possible.
- Traffic effects are anticipated to be minimal during these construction activities.

We are committed to keeping our neighbours informed about construction activities and responding in a timely manner to questions and concerns.
