RE: Construction Update – Fraser Grain Terminal Export Facility at 11041 Elevator Road, Surrey

We are writing to provide a construction update for the Fraser Grain Terminal Export facility at 11041 Elevator Road, adjacent to Fraser Surrey Docks.

What to expect

Starting 16 September 2019 and continuing until February 2020, crews will be completing marine work consisting of installing steel pipe piles and concrete pile caps for marine foundations. Please see the map on the reverse of this letter for location details.

- Nearby businesses and residents may experience a temporary increase in noise levels.
- Steel pipe piles will be installed in small groups intermittently with weeks in between sets.
- These activities will occur during the port authority's approved hours of construction: 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday (excluding statutory holidays).
- Adjacent neighbours may also notice an increase in traffic on roads near the Project site through February 2020 as deliveries for this work occurs. All trucks accessing and exiting the site will use designated truck routes and use site access roads.

We are committed to keeping our neighbours informed about construction activities and responding in a timely manner to questions and concerns.
