RE: Notice of Sunday Work – Fraser Grain Terminal Export Facility at 11041 Elevator Road, Surrey

We are writing to provide a construction update for the Fraser Grain Terminal Export facility at 11041 Elevator Road, adjacent to Fraser Surrey Docks. Our crews have received approval to conduct work activities on Sundays during the daytime hours. These electrical works required for cable tray installation will allow crews to complete this work while no other activities occur on site.

What to expect

- Electrical works will take place on Sundays from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from 25 August 2019 to 23 February 2020.
- Noise from these activities is not expected to exceed existing noise levels in the area. Limited crew members will be on site working at this time.
- Crews will use hand tools to install the cable tray and complete electrical works at ground level. Noise from these activities is not expected to exceed the existing noise in the area. Limited crews will be working at this time.
- The extension does not include other construction activities, which will continue to take place during port authority's regular hours of construction.
