RE: Upcoming Temporary Road Works on Robson Road – Fraser Grain Terminal Export Facility

We are writing to provide a construction update for the Fraser Grain Terminal Export Facility at 11041 Elevator Road, adjacent to Fraser Surrey Docks.

For the remainder of the summer and into fall 2019, crews will be working in and around a section of Robson Road, near the intersection of Elevator Road. Activities include installing concrete slabs for utility protection and associated road works. Please see the map on the reverse of this letter for location details.

What to expect

- **3 September – 4 November 2019:** Installation of concrete slabs in limited areas of Robson Road near Elevator Road. Temporary lane relocations will be in effect for a small section of Robson Road. Single lane traffic in both directions will be maintained and traffic control personnel will be in place to direct traffic as needed.
- This work will be completed during the port authority's approved hours of construction: 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday (excluding statutory holidays).
- Nearby businesses may experience increased personnel, equipment and traffic in the area as crews complete this work.
- Nearby businesses may notice a slight increase in noise and dust consistent with these types of construction activities.

We are committed to keeping our neighbours informed about construction activities and responding in a timely manner to questions and concerns.
